ORDINANCE 15-2022

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A VARIANCE FOR 501 S. 19TH STREET

Whereas, the owner of property located at 501 S. 19th Street has requested a variance from the provisions of the Herrin City Code to allow for building into the setback area.

Whereas, the request for a variance was considered by The Zoning Board of Appeals at a public hearing held on June 20, 2022, after notice of the time and place of the public hearing was published not more than thirty nor less than fifteen days before the hearing in the newspaper having general circulation within the City; and

Whereas, the Zoning Board of Appeals considered the request and voted to recommend to the Herrin City Council that the request for a variance to allow for building into the setback be approved.

Whereas, the Herrin City Council deems it in the best interest of the City of Herrin, Illinois to grant the variance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERRIN, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The request for the variance for 501 S. 19th Street, Herrin, Illinois, to allow for building into the setback is hereby granted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication in accord with law.

Section 3. This ordinance is passed pursuant to the home rule authority of the City of Herrin, Illinois.

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
