

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING PART OF ALLEY LYING SOUTH OF LOTS 6 & 7 IN BLOCK 7 AND NORTH OF LOTS 8, 9 & 10 IN BLOCK 7 AND PART OF ALLEY LYING EAST OF LOT 6 IN BLOCK 7 IN BELMONT ADDITION TO THE CITY OF HERRIN**

Whereas, the owners of lots in Belmont Addition to the City of Herrin have presented a petition of vacation of part of alleys, which is attached here to as Exhibit "C", and;

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Herrin has determined that it is in the best interests of the city to approve the vacation of part of alleys in Belmont Addition Addition to the City of Herrin.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL BY THE CITY OF HERRIN, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Vacation of part of alleys in Belmont Addition to the City of Herrin is hereby approved.

**Section 2.** The Plat of Vacation and Legal Description of part of alleys in Belmont Addition to the City of Herrin is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" & Exhibit "B" and made a part of the Ordinance by reference.

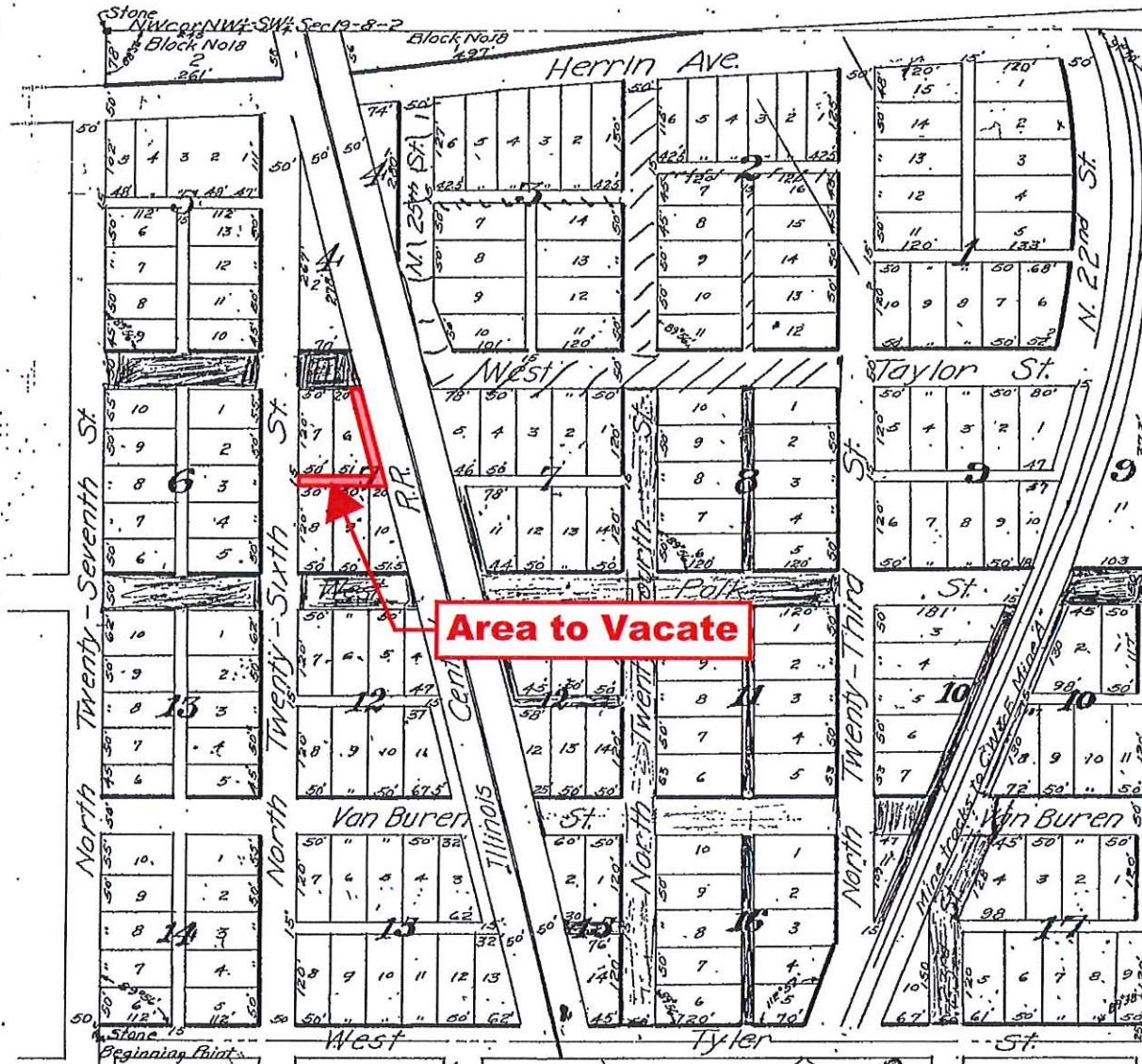

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
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
